ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: include the following, other duties may be assigned.

- The Adventure Workers are responsible for the safe operation of all Adventure Activities. Adventure Worker helps to support and affirm students or guests in their decision making process, always practice the model of "Challenge by Choice", and help students or guests gain confidence in a fun and safe environment.
- The Adventure Worker is responsible for being prepared to work each day in punctual matter.
- Adventure Workers work alongside Adventure Coordinator to ensure a safe and fun atmosphere for kids.
- Run assigned activities in a safe manner, including but not limited to: Indoor/Outdoor Rock Climbing Wall, Zip Lines, Waterfront, Gym, and Ropes Course.
