RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTIONS OF RISK

At NorthBay, health, safety, and supervision are paramount. The approach to safety and risk management is accompanied with competence, judgment, and purposeful sound programming. Guest safety and well-being is everyone's concern. As a policy of NorthBay, we require that a Release of Liability Form be signed as a requirement to attend camp.

I represent that I desire to attend a camp and participate in activities sponsored by NorthBay, LLC ("NorthBay"). In consideration for NorthBay permitting the Guest to attend the camp and participate in the activities, I have agreed to execute this Release of Liability and Assumption of Risks (the "Release"). I assert the information given on this form is complete and accurate to the best of my knowledge.

I acknowledge that participating in some of the activities sponsored by NorthBay, including canoeing, kayaking, boating, water skiing, hiking, swimming, snorkeling, tubing, fishing, rock climbing, zip line, sport activities, nature and acclimatization activities, and using the ropes course, involve certain inherent risks, including the risk of serious personal injury. I agree I shall assume all such risks, including the risk of serious personal injury. I agree I shall assume all such risks, as well as any other risks involved in any activities sponsored by or involving NorthBay.

I also agree to release and discharge NorthBay and all of its employees, agents, and representatives, as well as all other persons, corporations, or other entities that might have any liability to or me (the "Released Parties"), from and against any and all damages, actions, claims, and liabilities, whether known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, suspected or unsuspected, relating to or arising from me attending camp or being involved in any activity, occurrence, or event connected to Northbay.

This Release is intended to release and discharge the Released Parties from all damages, actions, claims, and liabilities arising from or related to the negligence of the Released Parties. I further agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend NorthBay from and against any loss, damage, liability and expense, including costs and attorneys' fees, incurred by NorthBay that is related to or arise from me attending camp or being involved in any activity, occurrence, or event connected in any way to NorthBay. I hereby grant permission to NorthBay the right to use, reproduce, and/or distribute photographs, films, video-tapes, and sound recordings of me, without compensation or approval rights, for use in materials created for purposes of promoting the activities of NorthBay.

The laws of the State of Maryland shall govern the rights and obligations of the parties to this Release and the interpretation, construction, and enforceability thereof. I agree that any lawsuit brought against NorthBay shall be brought solely in the Circuit Court for Cecil County, Maryland and, in connection with any such lawsuit, I agree that the trial will be conducted and determined by the Judge assigned to such trial, and voluntarily waive any right I may have to a jury trial. I further agree to pay any attorney's fees incurred by NorthBay if I attempt to contest the validity of this Release.

PREGNANCY – Adventure activities are NOT RECOMMENDED for women that are pregnant. If you have any questions please contact one of our staff members in Administration.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Payment & Cancellation: NorthBay will accept no less than 30% of the total. Teacher Professional Development cost at the time of registration to reserve your room. This deposit is **NON-REFUNDABLE**. The remaining balance payment is due no later than 30 days before the program begins. Failure to make final payment NorthBay will consider your reservation void and release your room reservation for potential alternate Teacher Professional Development Registrant bookings.

Rules & Regulations: The individuals named on the Teacher Professional Development Registration Form agree to abide to all of the rules and regulations established by NorthBay Adventure Camp. All Teacher Professional Development Registrant will be given a verbal NorthBay safety orientation at the beginning of the course.

1. Guests must leave the property, including individual rooms, in a clean condition.
2. Guest pets and skateboards/longboards are not permitted on the property.
3. The illegal use of the following are never permitted on the property: alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, firearms, dangerous knives, weapons, fireworks or explosives.
4. Smoking is not permitted in any of the restrooms, cabins or other buildings. Smoking cigarettes and cigars will be limited to various designated smoking areas only.

Guests will conform to all directives of NorthBay and all NorthBay's staff especially in the areas regarding the safety and well-being of each Teacher Professional Development Registrant. Failure to comply with NorthBay's rules and regulations can result in immediate termination of the Teacher Professional Development Registrant's stay at NorthBay and forfeiture of all payments to NorthBay.

Personal Property/Belongings: NorthBay is not responsible for any Teacher Professional Development Registrant's personal property or belongings while in transit to or from NorthBay nor while staying at NorthBay.

Damage to NorthBay Property: Each Teacher Professional Development Registrant will agree to pay for any damages to the property, including but limited to graffiti, buildings, facilities, and equipment or loss of NorthBay equipment that arises out of the Teacher Professional Development Registrant's use of NorthBay.
